

Why?

- -Very easy to modify or view settings
- -Visual, user-friendly interface
- -Not difficult to implement


How?

- 1) Client (web browser) sends request to server
 - Example: GET /config.html HTTP/1.1
- 2) Server answers the request, sending data the client requested.



Above left: The client which sent a GET request to the server. Above right: the server (XINU backend).







HTTP?

- -HTTP: HyperText Transfer Protocol
- -Protocol: Rules determining the transmission of data.
- -Headers: Extra parts of the communication process that specify details about the transfer of information
- Example: Transfer-Encoding: chunked
 The server sends this header to the client to
 tell the client that it will be receiving the data in pieces rather than all in one transmission.
